

How to Plant a Tomato in the Garden

- 1) Dig a hole twice the diameter and depth of the tomato root ball.
- 2) Place a small handful of our Organic Compost in the hole.
- 3) Plant the tomato up to the two top-most set of leaves and fill the remainder of the hole with Tomato Mix.
- 4) Pat gently – not too close to the stem – to ensure it is in the ground properly.
- 5) Water well.
- 6) For extra support use a stake or cage to stabilise the plant. If you need to tie the plant to the stake, old pantyhose or a soft material are ideal as they won't damage the stem.
- 7) Ensure you keep your tomato plant well pruned to get the best results.
